


## WARNING

## NOTICE

- The important safeguards and instructions outlined on this sheet cannot cover all possible conditions and situations that may occur. It must be understood that common sense, caution and care are factors that cannot be built into any product. Caution and care must be supplied by the person(s) installing, operating and caring for this lighting fixture.
- This fixture is designed to be mounted on a correctly installed standard round or octagon box or a through outlet box with a plaster frame. The box must be securely mounted to the structure of the building. The mounting bar and hardware supplied should be used. Directly mounting the fixture to the outlet box may make it impossible to correctly align the fixture.
- NOTE: For your safety be certain that the circuit breakers controlling outdoor lighting and equipment are GFI breakers


## FIXTURE PREPARATION

1. Remove the fixture, parts and parts bag(s) from the carton.


NOTICE: Before discarding the carton, double check to make certain that all parts are found.

## FIXTURE INSTALLATION

1. Fasten the ground wire to the green or bare copper wire in the outlet box or to the green screw on the crossbar.



 Fasten the white fixture lead wire to the white wire in the outlet box. Fasten the wires together with an approved fastener (wire nut). Starting about 1" below the fastener, tightly wrap the connection With electrical tape so that the connection seals the end of the fastener.



- 3. Connect the black fixture lead wire to the black wire in the outlet box. Fasten the joined wires as in step 2.
- 4. Place the fixture on the post and fasten it in place with the set screws provided ( in parts bag).
- 5. Fasten the tubes and bottom cover by using four finials.
- 6. Install the lamp (light bulbs).(not included) NOTE: This fixture is rated for Max 60 watt type B lamps

WARNING DO NOT EXCEED RECOMMENDED WATTAGE!

- 7. Put glass on the bottom cover, lock the fixture roof to the tubes with four finials. (Please take away the styrofoam from glass before installing.)
- 8. Lock the Loop to the fixture roof with 2 screws (in parts bag).
- 9. Restore power to circuit at breaker or fuse box.
